### A. Project Updates

1. Board approved the release of bonds on February 6th

# B. Reviewed Schedule

- 1. KMA will plan to start facilitating meetings in April.
- 2. State Plan review process takes anywhere from 3-6 months.
- 3. State will inspect the project.
- 4. Early review package can be footing and foundation only.

## C. Reviewed Design

- 1. Design and engineering team working to coordinate columns, ductwork, etc.
- 2. Review control station furniture with glazing to clarify need.

#### D. CM Contract

- 1. CM contract on track to be signed tomorrow
- 2. Planned to approve at February 20th board meeting

#### E. Legislative Update

- 1. Corrections bill reviewed by the House.
- 2. Move forward and will be reviewed by the Senate today.
- 3. Next steps for legislative vote.
- 4. Anticipated to be 3 weeks out for governor signature if approved.
- 5. Sales tax will be reimbursed by the State at the end of the project.

#### F. Reviewed Committee Governance
