For the quarter ending **MARCH 31, 2022**, the PBDTF seized and purchased:

1. A combined total of **4,555 grams (10 pounds) of Methamphetamine**, having a street value of **\$337,070**
2. A combined total of **510 grams (1.1 pounds) of Heroin/Fentanyl**, having a street value of **\$94,350**
3. A combined total of **1,253 Fentanyl Pills**, having a street value of **\$42,602**
4. A combined total of **766 grams (1.7 pounds) of Cocaine**, having a street value of **\$78,132**
5. A combined total of **5,307 grams (11.7 pounds) of Marijuana**, having a street value of **\$19,152**
