Harvest Specifications

Access

• Sale is private access. Lattitude/Longitude - Primary access location is Lat. 47.839N, by Long. 94.629W. Winter Only – All operations limited to winter, frozen ground or sufficient snow cover to protect soil surface.

Cutting and Skidding

- Stay within Boundaries Unless approved in advance by the Forester, all harvest activities shall be confined to within the marked boundary. Access roads, skid trails and landing areas proposed for use outside the harvest boundary must be approved prior to use. Failure to comply with these requirements may be subject to a \$100 penalty per incident.
- Stumps Average stump heights below 12" and as low as possible.
- Logging Damage Logging damage is injury to 30% or more of the crown; or bark damage exposing cambium of 50 sq.in. or more; or damage causing lean of more than 5 degrees from original. Damage to reserve trees, as identified on the Appraisal form, may be subject to a \$25/tree penalty
- Reserve tree cutting penalty Cutting any marked or designated leave tree without pre-approval by the Forester may be subject to a \$50.00/tree penalty.

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Harvest and Reserves

- Den Trees Reserve trees with obvious den and cavity usage, even if not marked to leave.
- Aspen clearcut. Reserve Ash <6" and all other species. Small bootleg of south stand has reserved Aspen marked with blue paint.

Landings, Access Roads, and Skid Trails

- Existing roads are sufficient. Landings will be roadside. Roads must be left in as good or better condition than before harvest. Sale plan includes 3 landings
- Landing Rehab Following use, most landing areas situated inside the harvest boundary should have logging slash scattered and trampled across the ground surface. However, slash shall not be so excessive that it cumulatively covers more than 50% of the landing area.
- Skid Trail Rehab. All skid trails shall be closed by trampling logging slash on the surface. Special attention shall be given to trails approaching draw bottoms, drainage ways, streams, lakes and wetlands to provide surface drainage and erosion protection.

Permits Required

• Written Permission to Bid - Written signed permission from a land owner with viable access must be provided to bid on this sale.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

- Rutting Contractor must be prepared to shut down equipment operations or hauling if thawing or wet conditions create the potential for rutting. Failure to comply with this requirement may be subject to a \$100 penalty per occurrence.
- Soil Protection Soils are subject to rutting if operated on when wet, stop activity if conditions may lead to rutting, compaction or displacement of soils. Keep BMP applications current to prevent erosion.

Slash Disposal

• Slash Scattered - Logging & R/W slash - 80% of all slash 3" diameter and less shall be within 24" of the ground. Areas exceeding this depth shall individually not be more than 1/10th acre in area and shall not be located within 33 feet of any harvest boundary or open road. Small wildlife piles are encouraged.

Tree Size, Marketing, and Special Conditions

- 4 inch TDIB Utilize all material from butt to a 4" top diameter inside bark.
- No excess culling Cutting long Butts or oversize tops to produce higher quality product must be done to retain marketable lengths of lower value pulp or firewood. Culling which leaves excessive amounts of wood in unmarketable lengths may be subject to a \$10.00 per piece penalty, unless the material is loaded and hauled off site based upon an estimated cord volume.
