Harvest Specifications

Access

There are several public access points required to complete this sale. Logger will need to leave all roads as good or better than pre-storm condition.

Cutting and Skidding

[•] Logging Damage - Logging damage is injury to 30% or more of the crown; or bark damage exposing cambium of 50 sq.in. or more; or damage causing lean of more than 5 degrees from original. Damage to reserve trees, as identified on the Appraisal form, may be subject to a \$25/tree penalty

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Harvest and Reserves

- Cut Trees: All Bent, Broken, Leaning trees. All merchantable Aspen, Balm, and Ash. Birch > 6" DBH in Aspen areas. Pine Plantations will not be thinned or harvested beyond what is necessary to utilize storm damaged trees.
- Leave Trees: Undamaged Pine, Undamaged Oak, Undamaged Birch < 6" DBH.
- Leave Trees: Reserve patches 1 acre and larger where younger aspen (Under 45 years old) is undamaged
- Some boundaries will need to be run at the time the sale is opened.

Other Remarks

Extent of sale area and volume are estimated as best as possible given the conditions. Communication between logger and forester will be key. The harvest area may expand if additional blowdown is discovered after the sale was written. The goal is to utilize as much storm damage as possible while keeping plantations in tact as much as possible.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

• Rutting - Contractor must be prepared to shut down equipment operations or hauling if thawing or wet conditions create the potential for rutting. Failure to comply with this requirement may be subject to a \$100 penalty per occurrence.

Slash Disposal

Lop and Scatter slash unless making wildlife piles.

Tree Size, Marketing, and Special Conditions

- 4 inch TDIB Utilize all material from butt to a 4" top diameter inside bark.
- Pine thinning guides to minimize Ips Bark Beetle Damage in residual or nearby pine. A) December 1–May 31: All cut pine material > 3" and pine logs must be removed or destroyed before June 1; B) June 1–August 31: All cut pine material > 3" and pine logs must be or destroyed within 3 weeks of cutting; C) September 1–November 30: may leave slash on site
- Private Wood There is a strip of private wood along part of the sale boundary that is NOT part of this sale. If the landowner sells this wood to you, to comply with Chain of Custody requirements of our certifying organization, the private wood must not be mixed or hauled with the County wood.

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

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
